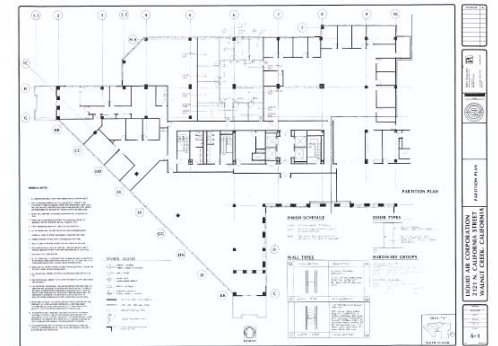
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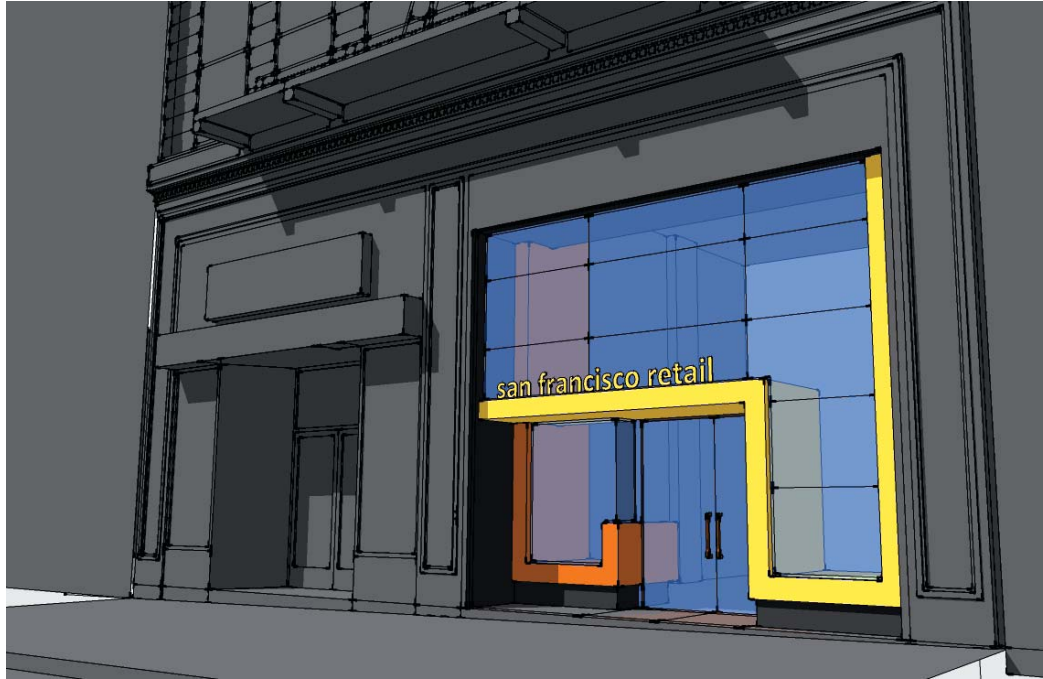

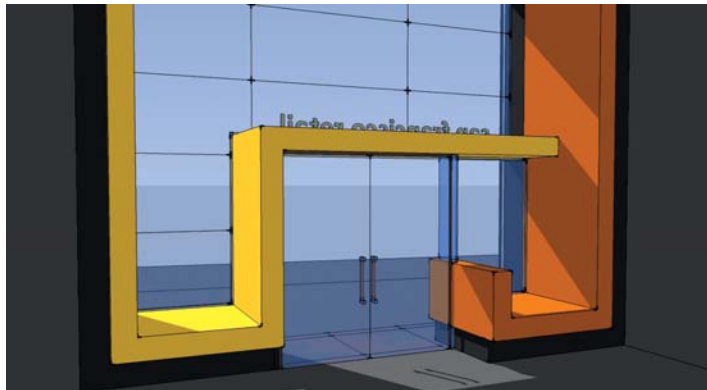

We were retained to develop ideas for a new storefront system for this historic building in downtown San Francisco.



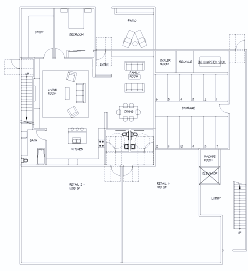
LIVING AND DINING ROOM

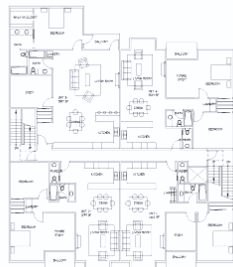
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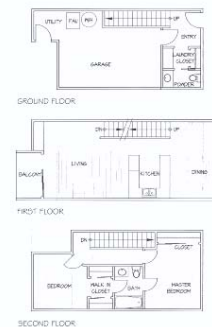
